

Light Effects®

Application Instructions

YOU WILL NEED:
Squeegee (included)

Spray bottle
Liquid detergent

Measuring tape
Window cleaner

Drop cloth or towel
Utility blade

- Measure window. Trim film on smooth, flat surface while still attached to paper backing. Film may also be trimmed on the window. Use a straight edge and utility knife.
- Clean Glass. Thoroughly remove any dirt or debris from the window. Light Effects film will adhere to a clean smooth glass surface. The product will not adhere to frosted or textured glass.
- Wet Glass. Add a couple of drops of liquid detergent to a spray bottle with cold water and wet window. Applying generous amounts of the water/soap mixture will make the installation process easier. Protect surrounding areas with a drop cloth or towel. Do not allow paper backing to come in contact with moisture.
- Remove Backing. Peel film from the paper backing starting in the corner. Protect the film from lint and debris. If film comes in contact with itself, carefully separate.
- Install Film. Wet smooth side of film with water/soap mixture and position the smooth side on the completely wet interior window. Film should be easy to slide into place. If not, peel back and add more water/soap mixture. When film is in place, wet the exposed side of the film. This step is necessary to allow the squeegee to glide over the film and remove all air bubbles and water. Squeegee from the center of the image and work your way to the edges. Trim any excess. Do not allow the edge of the film to be in contact with the window frame. This may cause the film to lift from the edges.
- Removal. Light Effects films do not use adhesives, they are easily removed. Slowly peel away from the window starting from a corner.

Helpful Hints:

- Light Effects films have a repeating pattern and will tile together when factory edges are matched top to bottom or left to right. During application squeegee towards the seam. The film will cover any size window.
- For best results apply Light Effects when glass is cool.
- When installing the larger 36" x 72" film, two people may be required to remove the paper backing and position on window.
- Not recommended for use in light fixtures, or near any artificial heat source.
- Some window manufacturer's warranties are voided when a window film is applied. Window film does not break glass. However, it can reveal or accelerate an inherent defect that is in the glass. Occurrences of breakage are rare.
